


Each Monday for the remainder of the term the children, accompanied by Pre-School staff, will join us for lunch and a Phonics session.










Class 2 has been exploring expressive art. We used different materials to 'mark make'. The children enjoyed applying colours using card, sticks and other tools they created!


#### ECO WORKSHOP
