This week Class 1 enjoyed dressing up and getting a little spooky! As October ends and November begins they have been creating some pumpkin soup in their sensory kitchen.

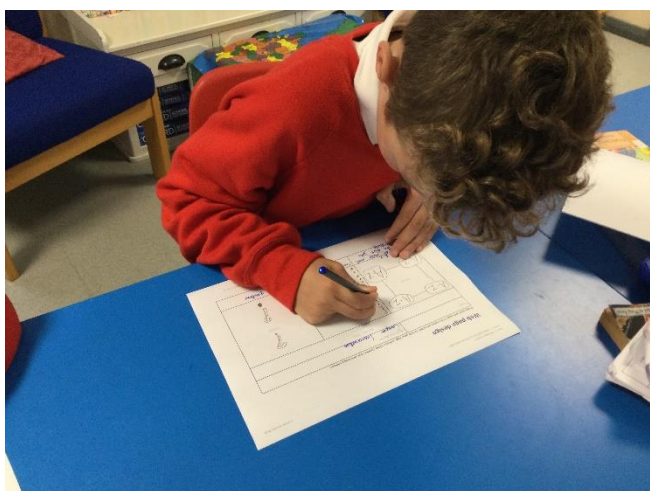

If you haven't already done so, please would you bring all sponsorship monies raised for the Swimathon into school by Tuesday 8th November at the latest. Thank you.



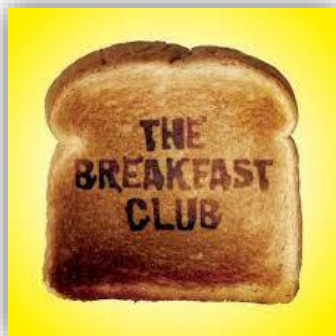
COAST & COUNTRY CALENDAR COMPETITION
