The children enjoyed walking through Island Street and Fore Street and learning about how the town has changed over the years.

Roger Barratt at the Maritime Museum provided a fun-packed morning. The children had a great time learning about the pirates of Salcombe! They all left the museum wearing eye patches with a 'haul of treasure'.

The Coxswain of the Salcombe Lifeboat, as well as arranging for the children to visit the Lifeboat

Station, kindly took them out onto the Lifeboat. What an amazing experience! He said, "It was a pleasure to show such a well behaved very smart group of youngsters over the boat and station".

As well as going onboard the Lifeboat, the children were also very fortunate to be allowed on board of the Royal Naval boat HMS Magpie.

We would like to take this opportunity to thank all the adult helpers who joined us on this visit and the RNLI and Maritime Museum staff for making this such a lovely and memorable experience.

3D SHAPES

This week Class 4 have been looking at 3D shapes in creating media for computing. 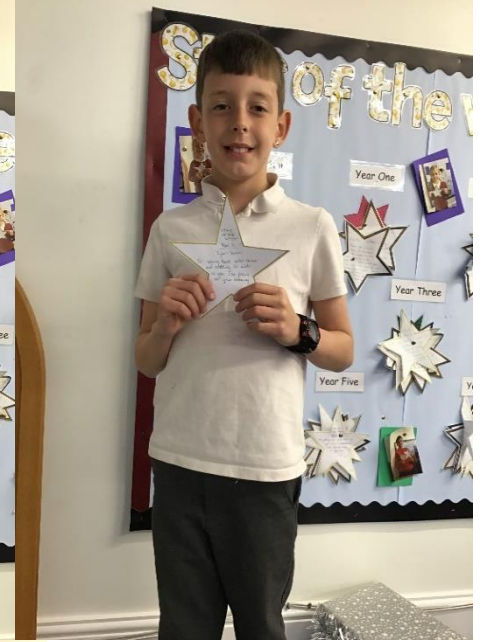
