We would also like to take this opportunity to thank Malborough Parish Council for presenting every child in our school with a commemorative Coronation bag.

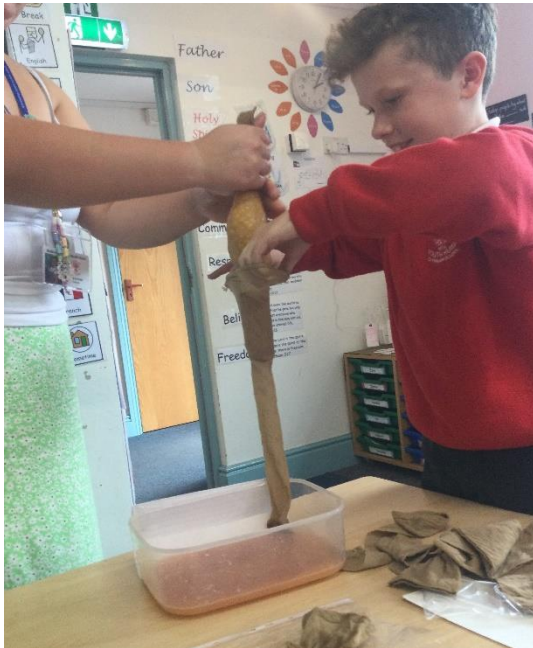
150th ANNIVERSARY CELEBRATIONS

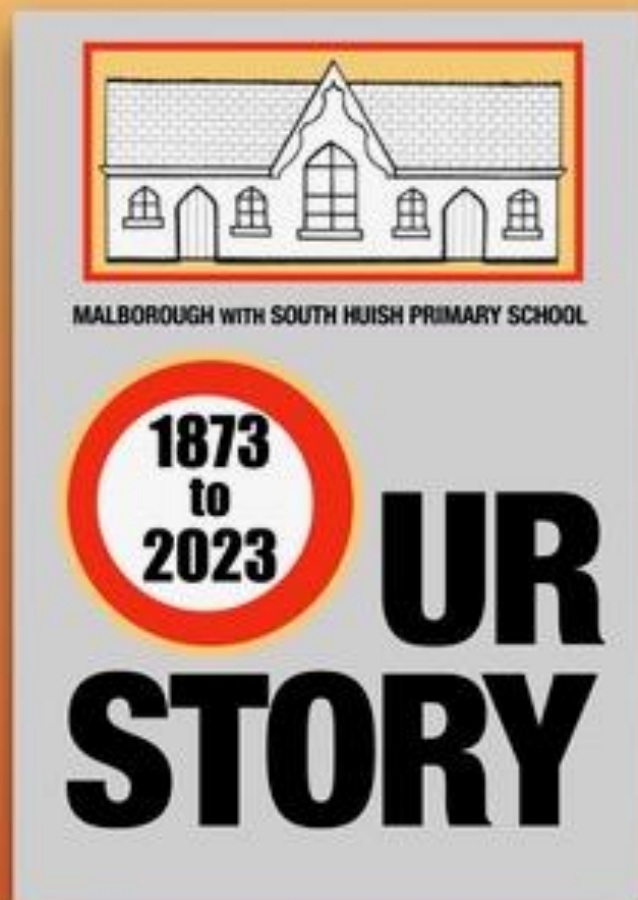
