
FRUIT SKEWER MINI BEASTS

SUMMER READING CHALLENGE

On Tuesday we welcomed Becky from Salcombe Library who came to explain to the children about the Summer Reading Challenge. Kingsbridge and Salcombe libraries are launching this year's Summer Reading Challenge on the 8th and 11th July respectively. The challenge encourages 4 - 11 year olds to read six books over the Summer Holidays. This year it has sports theme: 'Ready, Set, Read'. Children will get a challenge card to log the books they read, collect stickers for every two books and upon completing get a certificate, medal and a free swim at Quayside Leisure Centre. 
