

In science they have conducted their own enquiry, exploring which substances dissolve or mix in water and what speeds up the dissolving process.





CLASS 1

This week in Class 1 we took a trip across the land and sea to the coldest regions on the planet - to the Arctic and Antarctica for our Polar Explorers day! The children had the opportunity to dress up as either a Polar Explorer or as an animal that they would see on their adventures to the Poles!





We had fluffy, fearsome Polar bears, sweet and slippery penguins and some brave explorers! The children also created some Polar images, creating mixed media backgrounds and animal drawings for their foregrounds.

FOREST SCHOOL



Reception have been enjoying building dens and developing their whittling skills in their Forest School sessions.

This week, as the weather is so frosty and cold, Reception spent the morning on site.



They made lard balls for the birds using seeds, cheese and cereal. After they had made the balls, they hid and waited to see if any birds came to feed. They were delighted when some flew down to eat!
