### COFFEE AND CATCH-UP - SEND


Monday 29th January in the school dining hall at 2.45pm.

#### AROUND THE CLASSES THIS WEEK


This week in Class 4 the children have been working hard on drafting their ghost stories. They have all generated brilliant ideas for both setting and story using description well to build up the story ready for the appearance of their ghost!

In art, the children have been learning how to extend their sketchbooks in a number of different ways to create a more dynamic area to display their art.

In maths, Year 6 have worked towards the end of their ratio unit well, working through real-life problems involving ratio and proportion and year 5 have done incredibly well starting their next fractions unit with multiplying fractions by an integer.

The children have enjoyed separating materials in science using filtering and sieving.

We've had a great week in Class 4 and look forward to finishing off the week with some computing and music!







Class 2 had a lot of fun drawing pictures to depict the characters in the book they learnt about in Thursday's assembly about courage. Who do you think was more courageous, the lion or the mouse?
