

AROUND THE CLASSES

This week the children came to the end of their Dance unit in PE. Class 3 enjoyed working in small groups where they choreographed and performed their own dance routines.



In their art lessons this week, Class 3 have been learning about the artist Henry Matisse and have enjoyed creating collages inspired by his work.







Frozen Fun! This week Class 1 have become Scientists conducting their own experiments to try and free some frozen Polar friends!

They wanted to find out what would free their friends from their ice cubes the quickest: hot, cold or salty water. As scientists, they made a prediction as to which would melt the ice quickest.

They then used syringes to apply the water to three different ice cubes.

After their experiment they discussed their findings and thought about whose prediction was correct! They found that hot water melted the ice the fastest, however, they were surprised about how quick the salty water melted the ice too! They linked this to what they know from the world around them and talked about how Gritters use salt to melt the ice on the frosty roads!



Class 2 have been learning about their senses and using them to categorise different foods. They enjoyed tasting raspberries, carrots, pretzels, crackers grapes, pomegranates, tomatoes, peppers, pepperoni and sweets and had great fun deciding which foods went into which category.



This week, Class 4 have worked incredibly hard, finishing their draft ghost stories and then editing and publishing them. They have all done extremely well and their finished stories look great! Year 5 have been working well through finding fractions of a quantity and Year 6 have been working through some SATs practise papers. In History, the children learnt about the Viking raid on Lindisfarne and we discussed how to separate fact and opinion in an historical source. The children have worked extremely hard this week and the weekend will come as a well-earned break!
