AROUND THE CLASSES



Class 1 have been learning about Easter and 'The Last Supper' this week. The children re-enacted the story, drinking 'wine' (water) and eating flat bread. Mrs Nixon explained the symbolism of the bread and wine to them.



They have enjoyed learning how to classify different features in Science. Perhaps you could ask them to share with you all that they have learnt about scientific classification!


Class 2 have been learning about the symbolism of Easter in their RE lessons.

They decorated Easter Eggs using the symbols they had learnt about.



Class 3 have begun an exciting new unit in English based around Myths and Legends. They had great fun acting out freeze frames to learn the stories.

In Maths Year 3 have been looking at the relationship between multiples of 4 and developing their reasoning by trying different maths problems and writing on their tables with chalk pens.





Class 4 has explored a range of different objects and started to think about the materials which made up the objects. We discussed and theorised the properties of these objects and thought about why these helped make the objects useful.

In English, the children have moved on to drafting their own section of a Varjak Paw adventure and they've used the skills they've learnt to create a contrasting atmosphere and dramatic descriptions of their setting.

In DT, the children have started thinking about how to design a bird hide and attempted to build a scale model using marshmallows and spaghetti.
