After a busy morning and lunch, the children enjoyed an afternoon of Easter crafts in the Education Centre.

Our KS2 children enjoyed a 'Threads of Easter' tour in the church followed by Easter Cross craft activities in the Education Centre. Their visited ended with a tour of the abbey's beautiful gardens.

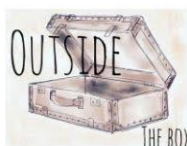
