Then they went star-spotting to discover the constellations as they would appear on Tuesday night and discover the stories behind them through the gods and heroes, myths and monsters from Ancient Greece!

KS1 had great fun immersing themselves in a hot rainforest, dry desert and the freezing arctic to explore some of the world's habitats through animal behaviour, adaptations and camouflage and to find out what we can all do to help protect our wonderful world.
