Welcome back! We hope you had a restful Easter break. The children have been fantastic this week and we have very much enjoyed the slightly better weather conditions. Class 3 had a successful trip to East Soar Farm on Wednesday, whilst the rest of us visited Church and discussed the concept of unconditional love during the retelling of the Prodigal Son.

As a school we continue to share our Christian vision, nurturing our children by giving them 'the roots to grow.' This term we will be focusing on Respect as one of our five key values. ## EAST SOAR

On Wednesday Class 3 spent the day at East Soar where they had great fun learning about various aspects of farming including livestock and crops. They had great fun taking part in a farm walk across the cliffs, exploring wildlife and the biodiversity on the farm during Spring and creating natural artwork in the Fairy Woods. They also enjoyed pond-dipping where they focused on life cycles. We would like to take this opportunity to thank Schalk and Marijke Herselman for organising such a lovely experience for the children and we look forward to taking Class 2 to East Soar next week.









## FARMING FUN

This week Class 1 has started their growing and farming unit and have been using this to inform their maths investigation exploring capacity by seeing which pot fits the most compost. We have also been practicing our counting to 20 and sorting into colours.



They have also been planting seeds with Mrs Tann. They dug and raked the soil before planting carrots and radishes and they potted chillies, pumpkins and cress seeds to propagate. They hope the seeds will have grown into lots of vegetables by the end of the summer term!
