Class 1 have been learning all about the number 3 in maths this week. The children have explored making groups of 1, 2 and 3 with different objects and looking for 3 in bigger groups.



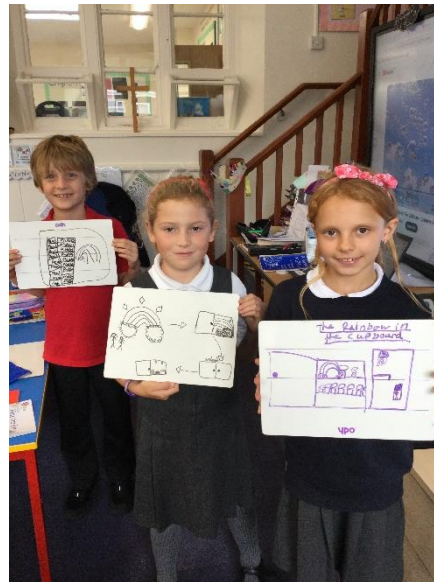
Class 2

In English, Class 3 are enjoying reading a text called 'A Passing on of Shells' by Simon Lamb, it features 50 poems of exactly 50 words each. The book uses the imagery of seashells to inspire hope, wisdom and creativity. This week, we studied The Rainbow in a Cupboard and How to care for a fallen Star. The children enjoyed listening to the poems and then creating their own illustrations to show their feelings when they listened to these poems. We also talked about why we liked or disliked both of these poems.

This week in English, we have been working on a shared write using an extended metaphor about ants to explore themes of teamwork, resilience, and community.

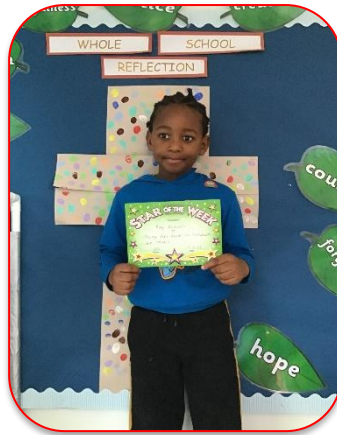

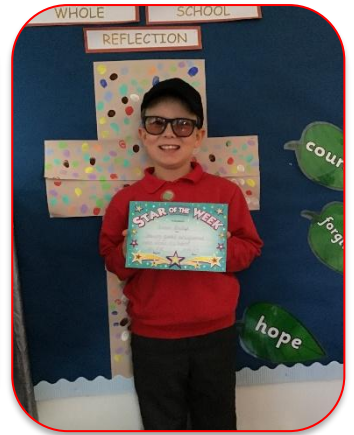
