CLASS NEWS

Class 1

We celebrated World Mental Health Day by doing lots of activities that make us happy. We popped bubbles and crafted superhero badges. We talked about when we feel happy and things we can do to help us feel calm.



Class 2

Class 2 had a wonderful time creating the printing presses in Art ready for use next time. We are looking at different patterns and textures and designing our own school.



Class 3

Class 3 have had a creative and curious week of learning! In English, the children have been enjoying stories about *Paddington Bear*, exploring his adventures and using them as inspiration for their own writing. They've worked hard on using interesting vocabulary and varied sentence structures to bring their stories to life.

In science, our shadow experiments have sparked lots of excitement and investigation. The children explored how shadows change in size and shape depending on the position of the light source, making careful observations and drawing thoughtful conclusions.

Art has been wonderfully autumnal this week as we sculpted clay pumpkins. Everyone showed fantastic creativity and patience as they shaped, carved and decorated their designs — we can't wait to see the finished results once they're dry!

Class 4

Children in Class 4 enjoyed exploring the separation of mixtures and discussing reversible and irreversible changes. They observed how heat melts chocolate into a liquid and then poured it into moulds. After chilling in the fridge, the chocolate solidified into delicious pieces—a scrumptious science experiment that everyone loved taking part in!
