JUNIOR LIFE SKILLS

Last Friday, Year 6 took part in a fantastic Junior Life Skills event at Quayside Leisure Centre. The day was packed with hands-on activities designed to teach pupils how to stay safe and make responsible choices in the community. The children had the opportunity to learn from a range of professionals, including representatives from the RNLI, police, fire service, and cyber safety teams. They also took part in a CPR workshop and explored how to respond in different emergency situations.



LEPROSY ASSEMBLY

On Wednesday, we were delighted to welcome Trevor, who delivered an engaging assembly about the Leprosy Mission and its important work around the world. Following the assembly, some of our Year 5 and 6 pupils kindly volunteered to help at the Marlborough Church soup lunch, serving the community with enthusiasm and a smile.

CLASS 1 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL

Class 1 have been exploring pumpkins and autumn leaves. The children have been filling pumpkins with water and rolling them down guttering. They used colourful leaves to create autumnal crafts, sorted leaves in the maths area and in the finger gym area threaded leaves.



CLASS 2 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL FOR YEAR 2 **PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY**

Class 1 and 2 had a lovely afternoon doing PE in the village hall. It gave us a chance to practise walking safely up to the hall where will be doing PE after half term.



CLASS 3 – PE TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY

Class 3 have enjoyed painting poppies as part of a display in All Saints Church for Remembrance Day. The red poppies are the traditional ones that we wear to remember all of the people who have suffered or lost their lives to war. Some people choose to wear white poppies as a commitment to peace. The black poppies were launched in 2010 to commemorate civilians, servicemen and women of Black, African, Caribbean and Pacific Island heritage who have contributed to the war effort. The purple poppies represent animals who have lost their lives serving in wars. Please take a look at our lovely work which is on display in church.



CLASS 4 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

In Class 4, we have been focusing on counting in sets of multiples up to 1,000. We gamified our learning by using dice to count in multiples — it was so much fun!
