CLASS 1 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

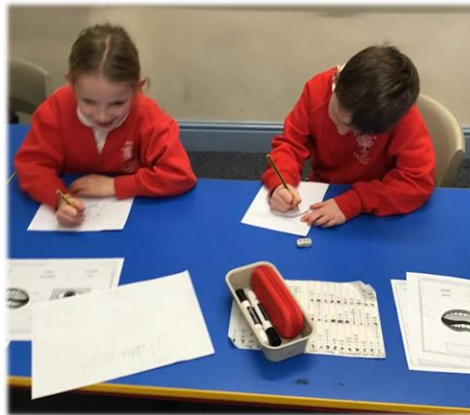
Class 1 have been enjoying visiting the school library. The children have chosen books to share at home with their families. The children spoke about how they like the books that tell you information and the books about princesses!

Please make sure your child has their sharing book in their book bag on a Friday so we are able to swap them. Thank you.



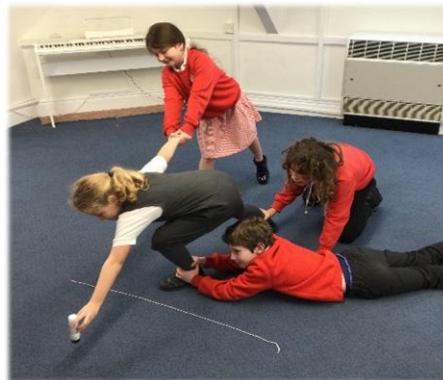
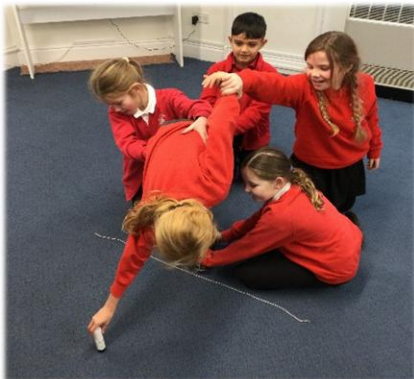
CLASS 2 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

CLASS 3 – FOREST SCHOOL YEAR 3 PE TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY

This week, Class 3 have been learning about states of matter in science. We have kicked off the new unit by looking at solids, liquids and gases. In PE we have enjoyed our new unit of dance and putting movements together to make a sequence. The year 3s have enjoyed forest school this week and year 4 have been practising their problems solving skills - working together to stand an item upright beyond a line without touching the floor, throwing the object or crossing the line. It was a lot of fun trying to collaborate and think outside the box.



CLASS 4 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

In Class 4, children have been learning about how the human eye sees light. They explored how a torch acts as a source of light and how the light reflects off objects and travels into our eyes, allowing us to see.

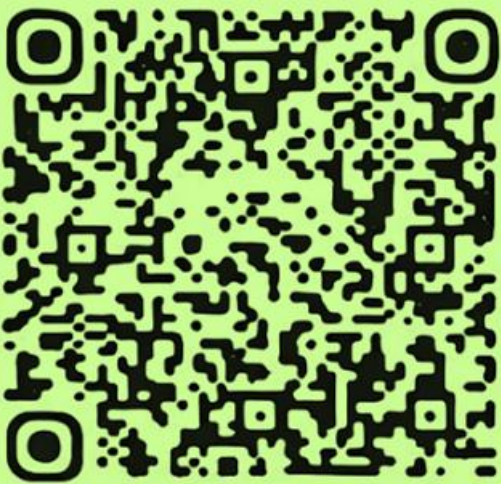
