## **CLASS 3 – FOREST SCHOOL YEAR 3 PE TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY**

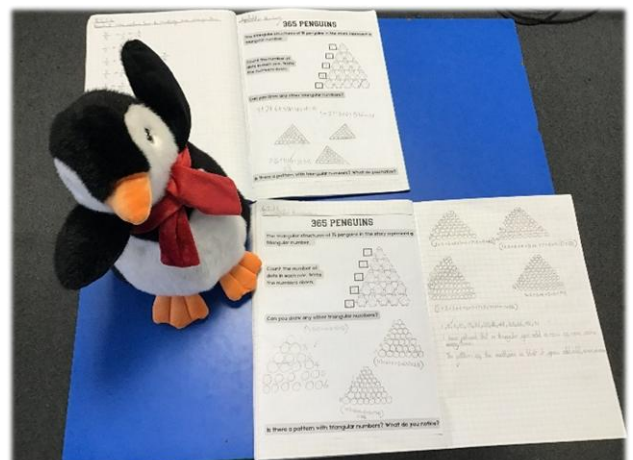
Class 3 have worked hard this week! In English, we completed our poetry writing based on the book 'A River' the children enjoyed writing their own poems based on research about a river of their choice. They included both facts and imaginative ideas to produce some super work. In Maths, we completed our unit on rounding 4-digit numbers, ready to develop our time telling skills next week. A highlight of our week was the mentos mint and coke experiment as part of our science unit on solids, liquids and gases. Everyone enjoyed watching the high-speed physical reaction, of an instantaneous eruption of foam!



## **CLASS 4 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY**

Year 6 have enjoyed reading 365 Penguins and learning about triangular numbers. The children explored a range of mathematical problems linked to the story and showed great enthusiasm when tackling challenges together.

We also played a variety of maths games throughout the day, including taking part in the national NSPCC Rocks Times Tables competition, where the children demonstrated excellent focus and determination.
