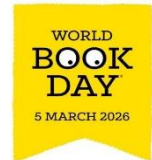
Dear Parents and Carers,

It was lovely to welcome everyone back to school and catch a glimpse of blue sky and sunshine.

CLASS 1 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

Class 1 have started the topic marvellous minibeasts! The children have been on a bug hunt, designed bug houses and have been serving up mud pies in the minibeast café! Our focus story is The Hungry Caterpillar and the children enjoyed acting the story out.

A gentle reminder that next Thursday 5th March on world book day, parents are invited in from 2pm to engage in book themed activities with their child. If you would also like to be a 'secret reader' in Class 1, please let us know. We look forward to welcoming you into the classroom!



CLASS 2 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

Class 2 have come back in and already working hard. The Year 1s are working hard in their maths and phonics. Year 2 are getting to grips with the 5 x tables and spotting the links between 5s and 10s.



CLASS 3 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL – YEAR 4 **PE TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY**

This week, Class 3 enjoyed practising our ball control skills in tennis. Our highest score of bouncing the ball on a racket was 88 by Annie! The year 3s enjoyed problem solving and worked together to play a game of place the pen. It was hard to get it across the line. In PSHE we looked at adverts and information online and learnt how to spot adverts and false information and compare it to official information pages. We have also been working on historical information pages in English, learning about vibrations and sound in science and expanding our multiplication knowledge in maths.



CLASS 4 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

Class 4 have been getting practical in Maths this week!

The children have been exploring nets of 3D shapes, carefully constructing them to understand how solid shapes are formed. They have also been developing their skills in measuring and drawing angles accurately using a protractor. It has been fantastic to see their growing confidence and precision as they applied their learning in a hands-on way.

In Science, we have been learning about light as part of their physics unit. They explored how light travels and investigated the difference between specular reflection and diffuse reflection. To conclude the unit, the children designed and made their own periscopes, applying their understanding of reflection. They thoroughly enjoyed testing them out in the playground, using mirrors to observe objects from different angles


