## **CLASS 2 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY**

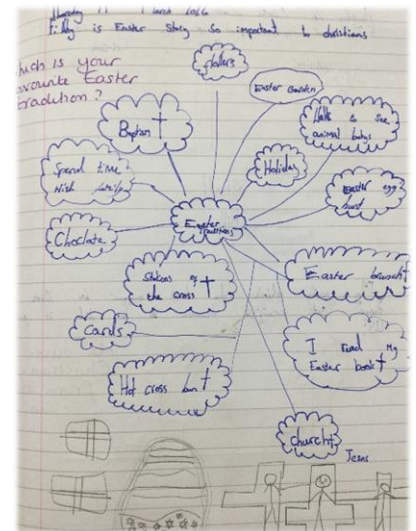
