CLASS 1 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

Class 1 tried different fruits and vegetables from around the world. We spoke about where the foods came from and whether we could grow them in the UK or not. The children enjoyed a delicious snack of fruits such as kiwi, mango, banana, baby corn, pineapple, strawberries, peppers and carrots. They were very adventurous and all tried something new!



CLASS 2 – PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY

Class 2 have had a fantastic final week of Summer Term 1! We have enjoyed carrying out exciting science experiments, creating our own mixed-up fairy tales and showing lots of creativity in our writing. Year 2 have also worked incredibly hard during their tests and should be very proud of the effort and determination they have shown. Well done, Class 2 — we hope you all have a lovely half-term break!



CLASS 3 – PE TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY

In Science, Class 3 became electricians for the day as they made their own switches and tested a range of materials to discover whether they were conductors or insulators. The children enjoyed predicting which materials would allow electricity to flow and recording their results like real scientists. In PE, Class 3 focused on developing their netball skills. They practised accurate passing, quick footwork and teamwork through a variety of fun drills and games, showing great determination and sportsmanship throughout the lessons.



CLASS 4 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL – YEAR 6 PE TUESDAY & THURSDAY

Year 6 had a wonderful time at their picnic on Thursday as part of their leavers' celebrations. The children enjoyed sharing their picnic lunch together, along with special chocolate cupcakes kindly made by Kim in the kitchen. The sun even came out, making the afternoon a lovely opportunity for the children to celebrate the end of their primary school journey together.

Year 5 and 6 enjoyed their first swimming lesson this week. The children showed great enthusiasm and confidence in the pool while practising water safety and basic swimming skills.

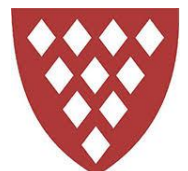
SEND COFFEE AFTERNOON - All parents and carers welcome

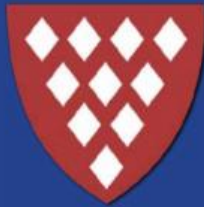
