Message from the Malborough Church Green Team & Eco Church

Rather than a work party, the Green Team will be meeting in church on Sunday 7th June at 2.00pm for tea, conversation, and a review of the progress made so far. This will include a look around the churchyard to see what is now flourishing, as well as revisiting some of the original projects such as wildflower surveys, wood piles, and bat boxes.

At the May PCC meeting, the parish was introduced to A Rocha's Eco Church programme. Eco Church offers Bronze, Silver and Gold awards for churches committed to caring for creation and reducing their environmental impact. Achieving these awards will not only support our stewardship of the environment but may also strengthen future applications for sustainability and renewable energy grants, in line with the Diocese of Exeter's commitment to Net Zero Carbon by 2030.

All four churches in the Seaside Parish are registered with Eco Church, although surveys towards accreditation have yet to be completed. Anyone interested in environmental initiatives within the parish is warmly invited to join the discussion, whether or not they have previously been involved with the Green Team.
