Dear Parents & Carers,

We had a visit from the Devon & Cornwall Fire outreach team who worked with children across the school to share key safety messages. The children were articulate and engaged throughout the morning workshops and shared a good understanding of how to stay safe.

On Wednesday afternoon our Y6 children started their transition to KCC with a visit and talk from Mrs Richards and are looking forward to their induction day in July.



Year One and Year Four pupils undertook their statutory screening tests this week. Phonics is a national requirement for all pupils in Year One whilst the Multiplication Times Tables Check is an online test for all pupils in Year Four. We were really proud of all the children who took their respective tests in their stride and we will update you with their results towards the end of term.

Next week we have a number of different exciting activities including: Space Odyssey visit for the whole school (kindly paid for by the Charity Ball), Y4 residential and Y6 Canoeing. We also invite everyone to join us for Sports Day on Friday 19th June at 1:45pm. Children should come in wearing a t-shirt in their house colour (please check with class teachers or the school office if your child is unsure). Children will be dismissed from the field at the end of the afternoon.

As a result of all these activities there will be just one swimming session for each year group next week:

- Tuesday: Class 1 and 2
- Friday: Class 3 & Class 4

Finally, the PTA will be running a tombola stall at the village fete. If you have any good condition unwanted teddies, please do send them in to the school office.

CLASS 1 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL **PE TUESDAY & FRIDAY**

This week Class 1 have been investigating floating and sinking. The children predicted which objects would float and which would sink. They thought the heavier objects would go under water and the lighter objects would sit on top of the water. We then carried out an investigation and created a table to show our findings.



CLASS 2 – PE TUESDAY

Class 2 have had a very busy week. We started on Monday with World Ocean Day and watched an assembly and some question and answer sessions. Children were asked to think about a 'blue' job they could do to help our seas and oceans. We started our new English book 'Julian is a Mermaid' and the children had to be detectives when they returned to the classroom to find sea glass, shells, images and a scroll.



CLASS 3 – PE TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY

This week, Class 3 have enjoyed playing and learning the skills for 'Throw Cricket' in PE. We have carried out scientific investigations on materials and their properties and made some excellent leaflets in English to entice visitors to our own made up worlds based on our class text 'Weslandia' about a boy who strives to celebrate his differences.



CLASS 4 – MONDAY FOREST SCHOOL – YEAR 6 **PE TUESDAY & THURSDAY**

Class 4 have really enjoyed learning about Earth and Space this term. They have explored the heliocentric model of the Solar System and learned that the planets orbit the Sun. The children researched and wrote interesting facts about how the Solar System works, developing their scientific knowledge and using accurate scientific vocabulary. They have shown great curiosity and enthusiasm throughout the topic, asking thoughtful questions and making links between their learning and the world around them. Year 6 had brilliant fun at forest school making fires and spinning tops.
