Skill focus: acrylic on canvas board painting



You will learn how to draw out a boat at anchor, (from an image) with strong, clear lines, onto a canvas board. You will find out how to mix and use tones of acrylic colour to block out areas. You will learn how to apply paint onto a surface for your desired effect and then build up those areas. We'll also explore different sky and reflection effects to add to the mood of your painting. By the end of the day you will have completed a high quality, acrylic painting on canvas board. Ready to put on your wall or give away as a present! Suitable for children aged 6YO+. No upper age limit. All levels of experience stretched and supported.
